The Rotary Club of Barrington...

The Rotary Club of Barrington was chartered in 1960, and is an organization of community, business, and professional leaders who are committed to making the Barrington Area a better place to live and work, and united with other Rotary clubs worldwide provides humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and help build peace and goodwill in the world.

Rotary International has an attendance requirement for all members. You will be expected to attend at least 50% of the weekly meetings. When you cannot attend your regular weekly meeting, you can do make up at any Rotary club anywhere in the world. Attending meetings in other local clubs, other states or other countries has proven to be one of the highlights of being a Rotarian. When you walk into another club's meeting, you will instantly be surrounded by new friends and be welcomed warmly.
