

Rotary Micro-Credit Program

The Barrington Breakfast Rotary Club (BBRC) is proud of its community service project, the Rotary Micro-Credit Program, which focuses on small loans ... often called micro loans.

Why is Rotary offering this community service project?

This project is about “*helping those who are trying to help themselves.*” It addresses and responds to the entrepreneurial spirit of individuals who need a helping hand.

Our goal is to attract motivated, focused people who are willing to work hard to uplift their life and that of their families.

The Rotary Micro-Credit Program offers these key features: It is for smaller amounts, it focuses on creating new sources of income, and it is personalized and customized to the opportunity at hand.

Motivation

Our motivation is to provide opportunity – not charity – for people who wish to start or expand an income generating business venture by offering seed money in the form of a loan.

The Loan

The loan (maximum amount of \$5,000) is granted at modest interest rate (prime + two points) with full expectation of payback. It is exclusively for entrepreneurial activity – not personal consumption (such as food, rent, medical expenses etc.).

Eligibility

A Micro-Credit recipient must be an American Citizen or Green Card Holder and live or have business in a geographical area associated with Rotary District 6440 as shown. There are over 70 local Rotary Clubs in this area. Applicants should contact their local Rotary Club for sponsorship.



All Applicants will undergo “credit” and “background” checks as appropriate.

The loan is given with the expectation that families will be able to supplement their income through an income generating venture.

Factors affecting decision

- Does the Applicant show commitment, dedication, and perseverance?
- Does the business venture have a reasonable chance to succeed?
- Is there enough cash flow for the loan to be repaid?

Mentorship

Once the loan is granted, the client will be assigned Rotary members to serve as Mentors. The Mentors will frequently talk to the client, assess the Client’s progress, and offer advice or support as appropriate.

Sponsorship

An applicant must be “sponsored” by a service club, business, or individual within the local community. The *sponsor* vouches for the applicant’s honesty, integrity and character, but will not be involved in handling any money nor will he/she be co-signing the loan.


