Official Charter Date: January 24, 1997

The history of the Bloomingdale-Roselle Rotary Club dates back to August 1996, when Chuck and Elaine Dobra, Steve Scholten, Jerry Gordon, and several others began discussing the feasibility of a Rotary Club serving the Bloomingdale and Roselle communities. By January 1997, with the help of 6440 Past District Governor Frank Schwermin (Highland Park) and leaders, especially Alan Gabe, within the sponsoring Schaumburg- Hoffman Estates Rotary Club, interest in forming the club was consolidated. Delayed by site availability, the actual charter night for the club was the very snowy evening of February 21, 1997 at the Tiffany Point Ballroom.

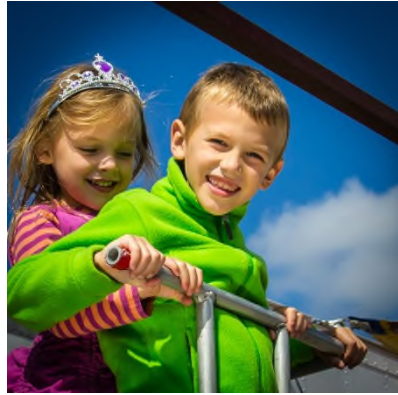

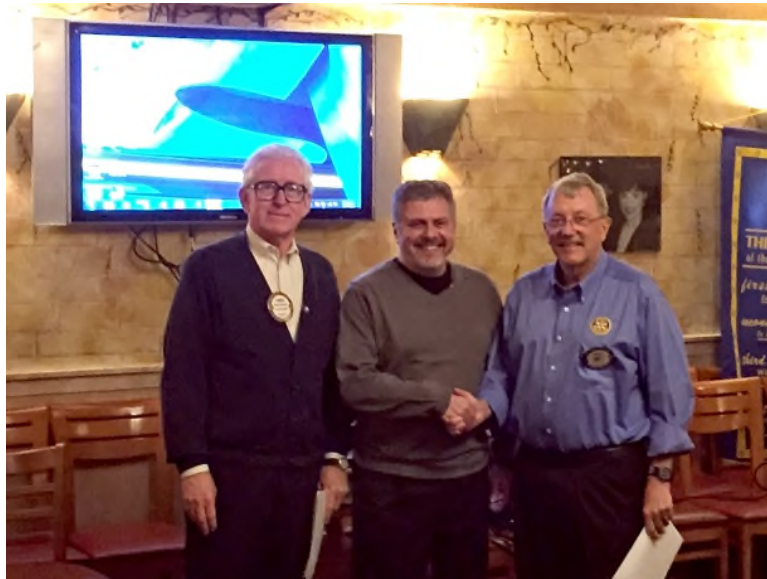

The Rotary Club of Bloomingdale-Roselle proudly honors Bill Wolff with the Rotary Humanitarian Patriot Award.

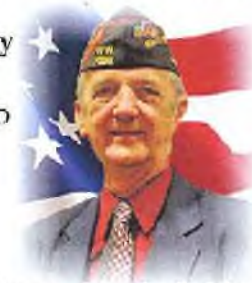
Bill is a charter member of Bloomingdale VFW Post 7539. He served with distinction as the Post Commander three times, winning All-American status; served as District 19 Commander; and was also named the 2010-2011 VFW Illinois State Commander.

While State Commander of the Illinois Veterans of Foreign Wars, Bill set two lofty goals: First, he aimed to "cover 2,700 veterans who reside in Illinois veteran's hospitals and nursing homes with bathrobes that fit." For this Special Commander's Project, he needed \$40,000; much above the \$10,000 previous State commanders had raised for their annual projects. During his year in office, Bill drove 58,000 miles, asking for donations and successfully raising the needed funds.

Bill's second goal was to escort a World War II veteran on a one-day Honor Flight from Midway Airport to Washington, D.C. This goal became a reality on April 27, 2011. Since then, Bill has continued to admirably lead the Post in a many ways.

First, he orchestrated the collection, packaging and shipping of over 10,000 care packages to our troops in Iraq, Afghanistan and around the world. Second, he has led over 100 funeral chapel services for departed veterans. Third, he has championed innumerable individual veteran causes. Examples include: helping to fix a heating problem for a wife whose husband was serving in Iraq, and helping a veteran with Traumatic Brain Injury around Christmas time who was going through a divorce.

Whenever a veteran's problem is identified within or outside of the Post, Bill can be counted on with creative solutions and works hard in achieving them. As a result, Bill is known locally, state wide, and nationally for setting an example of extraordinary commitment in the area of humanitarian support for veterans and their families.

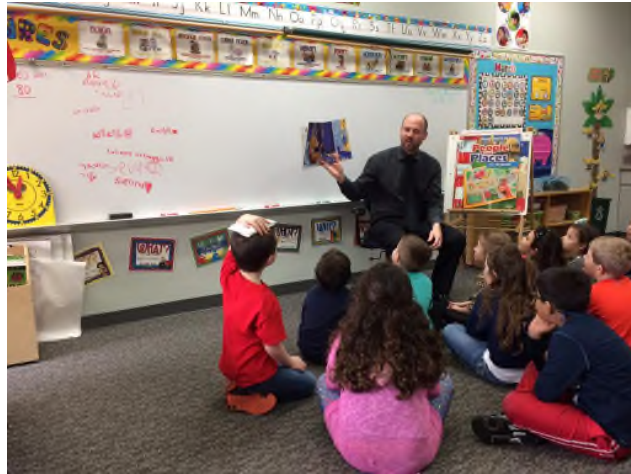

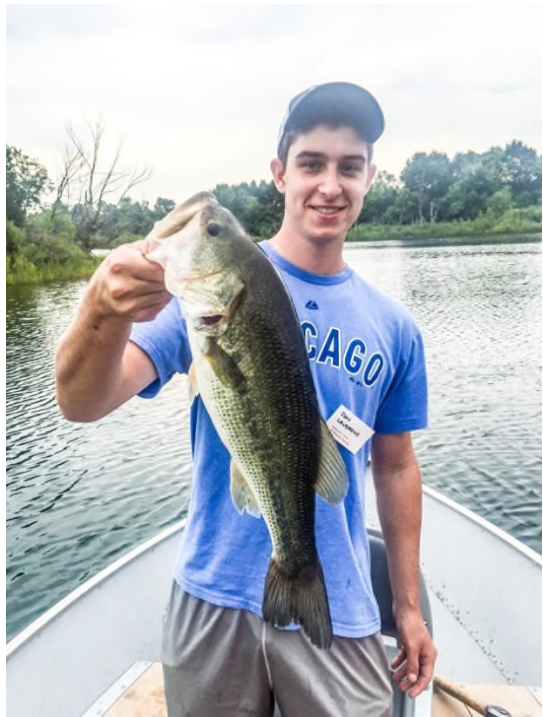

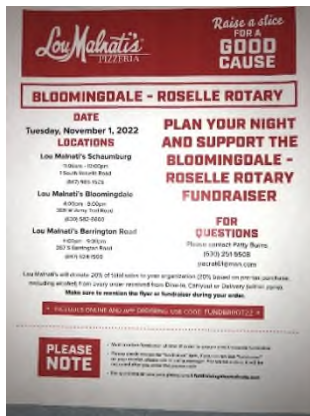
