The club's activities are centered around the following five committees to carry out the its annual goals:

1. **Club Administration** – This committee conducts the club's administrative and daily activities which might include:
 - a. Weekly program suggestions
 - b. Membership Communication
 - c. Website
 - d. Social Events

2. **Membership** – This committee develops and implements a plan for recruiting and retaining club members:
 - a. Identification & attraction
 - b. Member engagement/involvement
 - c. New member orientation

3. **Public Image** – This committee develops and executes a plan to provide the public with information about Rotary and to promote the club's service projects and activities:
 - a. Media news releases
 - b. Advertising & marketing
 - c. Web & social media

4. **Service Projects** – This committee plans and carries out educational, humanitarian, and vocational projects that address the needs of local and international communities:
 - a. International
 - b. Community
 - c. Vocational
 - d. Youth service
 - e. Fundraising (for club projects)

5. **The Rotary Foundation** – This committee develops and carries out plans to support The Rotary Foundation through financial contributions and club membership participation in Rotary Foundation programs:
 - a. End Polio Now
 - b. Annual contributions from club membership
 - c. Grants
