RESTAURANT & SOUP ENTRY FORM & COOK-OFF RULES

- 1. Registration deadline is February 7, 2025. Entry is limited to 12 restaurants.
- 2. Event features two divisions the Restaurant Division and the D211 High Schools/Culinary Arts Program Division.
- 3. Confirmation of your entry will be sent via email.
- 4. There is no fee to enter your soup.
- 5. One soup entry per restaurant. Restaurant must provide a minimum of 4 gallons of entered soup.
- 6. Restaurants must provide all equipment, promotional signage and materials for visual presentation.
- 7. We will provide the following: one 3'x6' undraped table, 2 electrical outlets for set-up, cups, spoons and napkins, tabletop sign featuring your soup's description as indicated on your registration form, tabletop tent signs to display in your restaurant leading up to event (encourage your customers to attend and vote for your soup).
- 8. Set-up time will be from 4:00-5:00 pm. Doors open to the public at 5:30 p.m. Event runs through 7:30 pm. at which time our Soup Cook-Off Champions from each division will be announced.
- 9. In case of inclement weather, event could be postponed or cancelled.
