

PEOPLE OF ACTION

Our club offers opportunities for our members and those interested in making a difference — to get involved. Through meetings, social events, and volunteer projects, our members learn about the issues facing our community and people all over the world, partnering with local, national, and global experts to exchange ideas about potential solutions and to draw up action plans to respond. Along with these opportunities to serve, members also are able to regularly network, resulting in lifelong friendships and business connections.

WHAT ARE THE TIME REQUIREMENTS?

Each member is required to attend four (4) Rotary meetings per year. The Member will pay for all lunches they attend. You may use cash or credit card to pay or lunch. \$20 per person. You are allowed to attend as many lunch meetings as you like on a "Pay as you go" basis. Each member may attend any Monthly Social Night on a "Pay as you go" basis.

Each Service Member is required to provide a minimum of 40 hours of community service annually. Community service may be in a Rotary sponsored project, Church sponsored project, neighborhood project or family project as long as you represent Rotary during your service time.

What kind of service projects do you do?

Each member is required to support the Schaumburg-Hoffman Estates Rotary fundraisers: The Classic - Dinner and Silent Auction (Every Year in Spring) - VACATION CLUB GRAND PRIZE DRAWING (Every Year in the Fall) financially - buy a ticket - or by selling tickets.

If ticket sales are made at a Rotary sponsored event this can be counted as community service hours because all of the monies collected go right back into the community through various organizations, we sponsor.
