- Only organizations serving Woodstock and/or District 200 residents may apply.
- ~~Funding will be provided to organizations for the purchase of goods or equipment. Grant funds will not be awarded for operating costs, salaries, or re-occurring costs. Recipients must agree to having purchased items labeled with Rotary symbol and to make press announcement recognizing Rotary gift.~~

- Community Service committee will review all applications and recommend grants to full Board.
