

# Rotary Club of Old Pueblo (Tucson) Board of Directors Meeting

### Minutes

### **Financial**

The restaurant is following protocols including sanitation, distancing, HVAC, and worker testing. Limited menu options will be available. Limited AV equipment is also available. Beta and Paul will inventory the equipment that the club owns and look into the purchase of other equipment to aid in the ability to conduct virtual and hybrid meetings for this event and for regular club meeting in the future.
