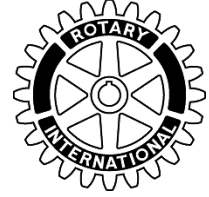

GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The Beaverton Rotary Club is offering educational scholarships to qualifying high school seniors in the amount of \$1,000 - \$5,000. Scholarships are awarded annually with payments made to the school at the beginning of the school year. The Beaverton Rotary Club College Scholarship recipients will be allowed to reapply for this scholarship each new school year with a four-year cumulative total.

The Beaverton Rotary Club and its Scholarship Committee do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, age, religion, sex, national origin or physical disability in keeping with the spirit of equal opportunity and compliance with all civil rights laws.

Any graduating senior currently residing in or attending high school within the boundaries of Beaverton School District 48 and who will be attending a four-year, public or private, college or university or a two-year community college located in OREGON, may apply.

Applicants will be selected based on the completeness of their application, academic achievement, community service, financial need, writing sample, oral presentation and interview.

In addition, selected finalists must participate in a personal interview and give a brief oral presentation in April. The Scholarship Committee will notify applicants as to the schedule for these meetings in late April. Although the committee will make every effort to accommodate scheduling conflicts, applicants who are not available for the interview and oral presentation will not be considered for a scholarship. Successful applicants will be recognized at a special meeting of the Beaverton Rotary Club in June.
