GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

As a recipient of The Beaverton Rotary College Scholarship, you are allowed to reapply each new school year for another \$1,000 scholarship. The maximum cumulative benefit per student is \$4,000. Scholarships are awarded annually with payments of \$1,000 made at the beginning of the school year.

Recipients must be attending a four-year, public or private college or university or a two-year community college located in OREGON.

Applicants will be selected based on the completeness of their application, academic achievement, community service, financial need, written presentation, oral presentation and interview.

In addition, applicants must participate in a personal interview and give a brief oral presentation in April. We prefer in-person interviews, but telephone interviews will be allowed. The Scholarship Committee will notify applicants as to the schedule for these meetings in early April. Although the committee will make every effort to accommodate scheduling conflicts, applicants who are not available for the interview and oral presentation will not be considered for a scholarship. Successful applicants will be recognized at a special meeting of the Beaverton Rotary Club in May.
