

# DUCKDEAL 2016 FAQ

# What is a DuckDeal?

A **DuckDeal** is anything <u>you</u> want it to be. It can be offered to just new customers, or to repeat customers. It can be a BOGO, or money off a purchase. The two most popular in 2015 were Gracie's Place Buy One entrée, get the second entrée free, up to \$20; and Merindorf's buy one pound of hamburger, get the second pound free. (Merindorf's reported that 'many' people coming in said they had never been in the store before!)

*DuckDeals* are Williamston Sunrise Rotary's way of saying thanks for being a sponsor, by helping you achieve your promotional goals. We will list all Sponsors offering *DuckDeals* on the Duck Race ticket itself, and we have arranged with Limner Press to overprint an 11 x 17" poster with your specific *DuckDeal* terms.

# Do I have to be a Duck Race Sponsor to offer DuckDeals?

Frankly, no. There is nothing to stop you from offering your customers a **DuckDeal** even if you are not a sponsor. You simply wouldn't be listed on the Duck Race ticket, or on the Duck Race webpage. The Duck Race is a community event, and participation is open to everyone. But we sure hope you will become a Sponsor.

#### How long will a DuckDeal be valid?

That is your choice: We will start selling Duck Race tickets on May 1, and your promotion can run for as long as you choose. We will put wording on the tickets that the *DuckDeals* will be valid until September 30, unless otherwise indicated by the sponsoring merchant.

# What if I need to change the DuckDeal in the middle of the summer?

That is the beauty of allowing you to structure your own *DuckDeal*. You will be able to change it whenever you want, by simply having the posters reprinted, and notifying us to change the website.

#### OK, where do I sign up?
