### **Write the date completed on each line item below:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete and turn in the information sheet from your induction packet to Janine.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Log onto ClubRunner at [www.anchoragesouthrotary.org](http://www.anchoragesouthrotary.org) – go to the member area and complete your information and upload a photo.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Download the Rotary ClubRunner app on your smartphone and sign in. Use this a quick and convenient contact info directory for contacting other Rotarians.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Log onto Rotary.org and click on My Rotary at the top of the page to sign-in and complete your membership profile.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Download the Rotary Club Locator app on your smartphone
- \_\_\_\_\_ Serve as Greeter for one meeting. You arrive early (11:30am) and great people as they enter our meeting room.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Read in visiting Rotarians and introduce yourself for one meeting. You read aloud the names, classification and what club they are visiting from off the sign-up sheets.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Sell split the pot raffle tickets at one meeting – need to arrive early to the meeting (11:30am). Tickets sell 2 for \$1.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend an Anchorage South Rotary Board meeting. They occur once a month and are announced at the regular meetings and an email usually goes out a day or two ahead of time as a reminder.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Participate in at least one of the Anchorage South Rotary community projects: Dictionary Project, Mother’s Day Flowers, Clithroe Center Dinner event, Garden Boxes project and/or the Parcel Post Party or a fireside. If you have a question on these, please ask your club sponsor or another club member.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Print the club roster off [anchorageoutrotary.org](http://anchorageoutrotary.org), then introduce yourself to 50 Rotarians and obtain their signatures.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend a new member social. These occur at least once a quarter and dates are posted on our website & on our Facebook group page, as well as at the meeting.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend a meeting of another club. There are nine clubs that meet weekly in the Anchorage area. See your sponsor if you need recommendations on which one to attend and use the Rotary Locator app to find when/where different clubs meet. This app is amazing and works internationally!
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have a coffee or lunch meeting outside of the regular weekly meeting with 3 past presidents of the club at 3 separate occasions.
