Scholarship – Spring 2019

## Kachemak Bay Campus – Kenai Peninsula College

The Homer Kachemak Bay Rotary Club is sponsoring scholarships for the Spring 2019 academic year. Applicants must attend the Kachemak Bay Campus and demonstrate the best combination of financial need, academic achievement, career goals and Rotary principles. Applicants may apply for both semesters on the same application form.

### Criteria:

1. Applicants must be fully admitted to a KPC or UAA certificate or degree program by award date.
2. Applicants must have earned less than 60 university credits.
3. Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits, however, *preference* may be given to applicants enrolled in 12 or more credits.
4. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75. Verification of GPA will be made prior to disbursement of scholarship check by the appropriate KPC or UAA office.
5. Other financial awards will be considered to determine financial need for these scholarships.
6. Applicants may be asked by the Rotary Scholarship Committee for a personal interview.

### Completed Applications Must Include

1. This page signed and dated.
2. Copy of transcripts to verify 2.5 gpa from most recent high school or 2.75 college gpa.
3. A completed and signed **Financial Needs Assessment** form. Be sure to indicate the types and amounts, of any form of financial aid you have applied for and/or received for the upcoming semester.
4. A typewritten description of:
  - a. Your community Service and Volunteer Activities;
  - b. Your future education and career goals; and
  - c. Your basis for financial need.
