

The first four Rotarians

On 23 February 1905, Paul P. Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram E. Shorey gathered in Loehr's office for what would become known as the first Rotary club meeting. Harris's desire for camaraderie among business associates brought together these four men and eventually led to an international organization of service and fellowship.

Juneau Mayor Merrill Sanford proclaimed Feb 23, 2014 World Rotary Day. Following several Whereases, he proclaimed:

THEREFORE, I, Mayor Merrill Sanford, do hereby proclaim Thursday, February 23, 2014 as World Rotary Day, and encourage all citizens to join me in recognizing Rotary International for its 109 years of service to improving the human condition in local communities around the world, and recognize as well the Rotary Clubs of Juneau.
