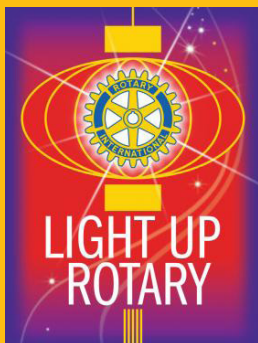

- Member of the Alaska Historic Commission, appointed by Gov. Parnell. The Commission is in

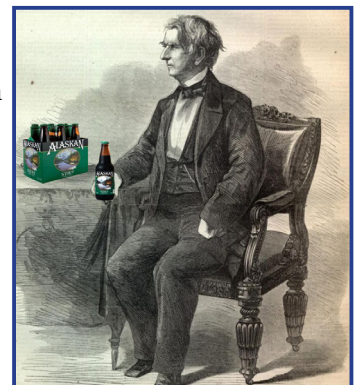
