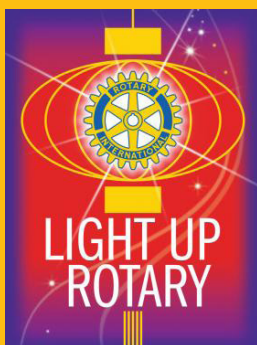

Dr. Huang is the full-time physician at Southeast Radiation Oncology.

- Oncology training at The M.D. Anderson Cancer Center, the #1 ranked cancer hospital in the world
- Formerly practiced at The Cleveland Clinic
- Medical School at Baylor College of Medicine

Dr. Huang serves as a scientific peer reviewer for several leading medical journals, including the International Journal of Radiation Oncology, Biology, Physics, and Breast Diseases Quarterly. He has received numerous awards for outstanding scientific research in breast and prostate cancer, including: the RSNA Roentgen Fellow Research Award, the Gilbert Fletcher Research Award, and the James Alexander Symposium.

Dr. Huang has been invited to present his research at numerous international conferences for prostate, breast, and lung cancer, including the American Association for Cancer Research, the American Society of Clinical Oncology, the American Society for Radiation Oncology, and the American Radium Society.

Dr. Eugene Huang has over 40 original scientific peer-reviewed publications.

At some point, you've needed to find a couch, an apartment, concert tickets, a plumber, a garage sale. And chances are, you've spent some time perusing craigslist.org, the online classified ad website that encompasses more than 700 local sites in 70 countries.

There's an actual guy named Craig behind craigslist, one of the 10 most visited English-language websites in the world. He's 62-year-old Craig Newmark, and he does more than help people peddle tickets and used furniture.

Through his other online venture, [craigconnects.org](http://craigconnects.org), Newmark advocates using technology for social good. On the site, he dispenses advice, posts surveys, and highlights research of interest to those striving to make the world a better place. He also publicizes information about groups involved in the causes he's most passionate about: military families and veterans, quality journalism, public diplomacy, open government, consumer protection, technology for the common good, and voter protection.

Newmark says [craigconnects.org](http://craigconnects.org) is a natural extension of his previous work: "Craigslist was always about helping others put food on the table, a roof over their heads."
