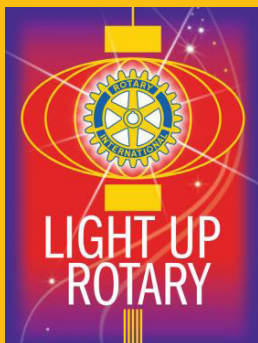

This Week's Program: Anna Burton, Juneau Rotary Project, Mendenhall School Playground

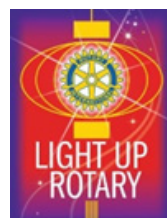
