CRITERIA AND EVALUATION RANKING

25%	Service experience and Letters of recommendation attesting to your Service skills
20%	Academic achievement, challenging coursework (AP, IB classes, etc.) Attendance record
15%	Community Service and Extra-curricular activities
20%	Essay - "What does community service mean to you? How has your service benefited others? How do you plan to incorporate community service into your career?" (500 word maximum)
20%	Interview with Rotary Committee – You will be asked to recite the Rotary 4-way Test .
