PARTICIPANTS

Any graduating High School, Charter School, or Home School Student within the Mat Su Valley.

One (1) Scholarship in the amount of \$5,000, one (1) Scholarships in the amount of \$3,000, and two (2) Scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 and thre (3) Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to graduating students from an area High Schools, Home School, or from a Technical School. These awards are intended for graduating seniors with outstanding leadership skills, high academic achievement, and participation in extra curricular activities, commitment to community service, and a plan to attend college, a university or continuing education program, or technical school.
