Any Graduating High School or Home School Student within the Mat Su Valley.

One (1) Scholarship in the amount of \$5,000, one (1) Scholarships in the amount of \$3,000, and two (2) Scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 and thre (3) Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to graduating students from an area High Schools, Home School, or from a Technical School.
