

## Paul Netzel's Continuing Rotary International Service

Just in case some LA5 members think that Paul Netzel ended his international service commitment to Rotary when his term as 2007-9 R.I. Director ended, we offer an update as follows:

Paul initiated the Rotary Ethics Initiative in 2007. Its focus is on creating ethics-related programs and training modules for use with Interact, Rotaract and Rotary Clubs. He will head up a full day session on ethics-related issues for New Generation Rotarians and Rotarians during the 2012 Rotary Institute.

Paul also serves as Global Chair of the Rotary Foundation's Peace Centers Major Gifts Initiative, which is charged with raising \$95 million worldwide to permanently endow the RPC's program. This Global Chair oversees a committee of 14 Rotarians from 9 countries representing every continent. To date, \$63 million has been raised, with a goal of raising the entire \$95 million by June 30, 2013.

He is also Moderator of the 2012 Rotary International Assembly in San Diego this coming January. This two week program trains all 532 incoming District Governors.

In addition to all of this, he will also chair the Rotary International Vocational Service Committee.
