To qualify, you must first win a SPEECH contest at your local Rotary club and advance to District level.

#### Official Rules:

#### WRITTEN SPEECHES ARE DUE BY 5 P.M. MARCH 12, 2021 (e-mail recorded file or link)

- 2. Contestant must be currently enrolled in high school or home schooled, and of high school age.
- 3. Speech must be an original work, 4 to 6 minutes in length, composed by the contestant. Speakers will be given timing cards at 4 min., 5 min. and 6 min., and will be disqualified if they speak longer than 6 minutes 30 seconds. Quotes may be used but should be no more than 10% of the speech.
- 4. Speech must not be read or delivered from notes. One 3"x5" note card will be allowed.
- 5. Contestant may be asked to present at the sponsoring Rotary Club on **March 17, 2021** via zoom.
- 6. Winners will be announced March 17
- 7. Club winners will advance to the District finals to be held **April 17**, **2021** virtually via Zoom.
- 8. Winners will be automatically enrolled in the District competition. Culver City Rotary will pay the \$145 entry fee.
- 9. If the contestant is under 18 years of age, the Registration/consent form must be signed by their parent/legal guardian.
