1. ARTWORK IS DUE BY 5 P.M. MARCH 12, 2021 (e-mail PDF file or link)

- 2. Contestant must be currently enrolled in high school or home schooled, and of high school age.
- 3. Art entry must be an original work, created by the contestant.
- 4. Medium: Entry must fall into one of the following categories of painting, drawing, photography, ceramic or sculpture.
- 5. Dimensions: Entry may not exceed 50 inches in any one direction, i.e. 50"H, 50"W and 50"D
- 6. Color PDF of art piece MUST accompany the application.
- 7. Contestant may be asked to present at the sponsoring Rotary Club on **March 17, 2021**, via zoom.
- 8. Winners will be announced March 17
- 9. Club winners will advance to the District finals to be held April 17, 2021 virtually via Zoom.
- 10. Winners will be automatically enrolled in the District competition. Culver City Rotary will pay the \$145 entry fee.
- 11. If the contestant is under 18 years of age, the Registration/consent form must be signed by their parent/legal guardian.
