To qualify, you must first win a VISUAL ART contest at your local Rotary club and advance to District level.

The First Place Winner at District level is invited and expected to present their work at the District 5280 Conference May 13-16, 2021.

- 1. ARTWORK IS DUE BY 5 P.M. MARCH 12, 2021 (e-mail PDF file or link)**
- Contestant must be currently enrolled in high school or home schooled, and of high school age.
- Art entry must be an original work, created by the contestant.
- Medium: Entry must fall into one of the following categories of painting, drawing, photography, ceramic or sculpture.
- Dimensions: Entry may not exceed 50 inches in any one direction, i.e. 50"H, 50"W and 50"D
- 6. Color PDF of art piece MUST accompany the application.**
- Contestant may be asked to present at the sponsoring Rotary Club on **March 17, 2021**, via zoom.
- Winners will be announced March 17
- Club winners will advance to the District finals to be held **April 17, 2021** virtually via Zoom.
- Winners will be automatically enrolled in the District competition. Culver City Rotary will pay the \$145 entry fee.
- If the contestant is under 18 years of age, the Registration/consent form must be signed by their parent/legal guardian.
