

Sourena Vasseghi Thinks and Writes While Linda Montellano Werner Talks how "Big Dreams Take Small Sacrifices"



Those lucky enough to have been at the May 7th Malibu Rotary Club saw an extraordinary person, Sourena Vasseghi. Sourena is an award-winning author and inspirational speaker whose stirring effect on people has attracted a rapidly growing national audience. Because Sourena suffers from severe cerebral palsy, he has limited motor skills and a significant speech impediment. These limitations, however, don't preclude him from living a fully

successful life from his wheelchair—and being an inspiration to all!



Sourena has made his life's ambition to inspire people to love their lives and live them to the fullest.

From his Love Your Life seminar series, Sourena's award-winning book *Love Your Life and It Will Love You Back* was born. This impressive man is exceptional not only for his numerous accomplishments, but because he achieves them all while living with a severe case of Cerebral Palsy, the result of his being deprived of oxygen for 10 minutes when he was born

Because of CP caused speech impediment it is hard understand to Sourena when he talks. CP has affected his motor skills, not his mind, and he is thinking all the time about life, and how he, his words and his zest for life can be an inspiration To others. understandably speak his words Sourena has had people who can understand his spoken words assist him, to act



in Iran October 21, 1977. His parents brought him to the United States when he was 2 for better medical diagnosis, and possible treatment. He was diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy (CP) at the UCLA medical center. Because of the CP he needs assistance with eating, getting dressed, using the restroom and other activities that require muscle movement.

Sourena started his education at a school for the disabled in Westlake Village, but after a few years teachers recommended that he mainstream into a regular school. By the time he was in 7th grade in he was in all the regular classes. When he graduated from Agoura Hills High School his goal was to prepare for college along with everyone else. When he graduated from USC with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration with an emphasis in Marketing his fellow students and their families gave him a standing ovation during the graduation ceremony. He could not have been more proud of his accomplishments. His efforts clearly paid off. Sourena came away from those experiences realizing that he was destined to impact others lives by simply sharing a piece of himself with them.

Sourena brought a manuscript of his first book to USC Head Football Coach Pete Carroll when both were at USC. Pete was so impressed by Sourena and his tenacious winning attitude that he had Sourena address the football team regularly. On the cover of Sourena's book *Love Your Life and it will Love You Back* is a quote from Pete Carroll: "Sourena's heart and passion for living has inspired me and changed my life."

How can a guy who deals with cerebral palsy (CP) and its limitations speak out about living life to the fullest? Indeed, how can a guy with a serious speech impediment due to CP create a successful speaking business? Motivational speaker Sourena Vasseghi has had to learn-more urgently than most-that if you truly love your life, it will love you back. Because Sourena believes there is no greater motivation than love, he applies the principles of creating a successful love relationship to creating a successful life-one that embraces limitations while finding ways to feel joy, passionate, and gratitude every day.

Sourena's second book, *Big Dreams Take Small Sacrifices*, will be launched at an event at the Sheraton in Agoura Hills on May 22nd from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. Sourena says, "Please join me. I will feed you, make you laugh and make you think."
