

ClubRunner site which has the simple, easy to remember web address of www.maliburotary.org, and the Malibu Rotary Club Facebook page, which is not so easy to find unless you have a facebook account and search for it in the facebook search bar (search for "Rotary Club of Malibu"). Screen shots of both of these websites are below. For those who have facebook accounts we encourage you to "Like" the Malibu Rotary Facebook site. If you don't have a facebook account then you have no idea what I'm talking about.

The ClubRunner site (maliburotary.org) is the one that all Malibu Rotarians should be familiar with because it has the answers to most questions that I am asked constantly, and I don't have time to answer all the questions in person because I have my own business to run.

By just typing www.maliburotary.org into the address bar of your internet browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari, or Chrome) most questions regarding Malibu Rotary Club meetings will be answered. You don't even have to "Log In" to find out where the meetings are, who all the upcoming speakers are, what the events are, and of course see archives of each issue of the weekly *Malibu Rotary Club Surfwriter* since January, 2009. The dates of the weekly newsletters are along the right side of the page and clicking on the date will open a pdf copy of the entire newsletter. The Calendar Index tab at the top of the page will open the present months calendar, and not only will show future months, but you can go backward in history and see who the speaker was for every since 2009. On the left side of the front page a links to local community papers and people and organizations, videos, that are of interest to Malibu Rotarians. And of course there are links to Rotary International and Rotary District sites. Down at the bottom of


the right side of the home page is a list of club officers and if you click on any you can send an email to that person through ClubRunner, even though you will not see their e-mail address. ClubRunner maintains the security of club member e-mail addresses unless are a member and have been assigned login and allowed to see the "members only" contents that lies within.

So if the general public can see all this stuff what is the special stuff that only members get to see? We're coming to that. The login is at the upper right corner of the home page.

Every member of the Malibu Rotary Club has been assigned a log in ID and password. I know what everyone's ID is. Password protocols have changed over the years and even though I gave each member a password I don't know what everyone's current password. If you don't know what your password is you can reset it when you login.

If you are a member of the Malibu Rotary Club your ID is the initial of your first name followed by your last and the number 2529.

For example, my ID is jelman2529.

There are several categories in the admin page and not all members can access all sections. It is where speakers and events are added to the calendar. Up until now I have been the only one to add speakers. I would like other members to go into the site and add speakers. If Wednesday has no one scheduled on the calendar assume it is available for a speaker. When inviting someone to speak don't ask me—just check the calendar and do it yourself. Everyone can open all the categories under "My ClubRunner." You can also see the complete Club Roster with everyone's telephone numbers, addresses, pictures, and as much of a biography as people want to put. It also has places for attendance, where you can put makeups, and also an email message center where you send e-mails not only to all the other club members, but also to all the presidents, president elects, and secretaries of all the other clubs in the district. In other words, when you login you get the key to the executive washroom. Pretty cool, huh?

So to sum up. If you want to know what's going on check the website first, and if you want to

2002-06-30 04:00:00 PDT Los Angeles -- Dick Clark has purchased a 12-acre Malibu home known as Gull's Way for close to \$15 million.

The multiple Emmy-winning producer and TV host, whose hit rock 'n' roll show "American Bandstand" marked its 50th anniversary in May, bought Gull's Way as an investment, sources said.

The oceanfront property has been described as one of the best building sites in Malibu. It is bordered on three sides by the ocean.

The property also has a 6,600-square-foot main house, built in the early '70s, and an 1,800-square-foot guest house, built in 1956. The main house is habitable but has been neglected. There is also a caretaker's cottage, a beach house and a pet cemetery on the grounds.

Gull's Way belonged to Pepperdine University before Clark bought it. The property was given to the school when Luella "Billie" Ulrich died at age 99 in 1996. She had hoped that the university could build a conference center on the site, but Pepperdine couldn't get city approvals.

Ulrich lived on the grounds for more than 50 years, much of it with her husband, Rick, who died earlier. The couple, who owned several mobile home parks, bought the site in the '40s and lived there in a trailer until they built the guest house. When the guest house was completed, they moved into it until the main house was built.

The main house, which has a fountain and several murals made with Malibu tiles, has been used as a set for many movies and such TV series as "Fantasy Island" (1978-1984). Few weddings have been held there, but the late Herve Villechaize, who played Tattoo in "Fantasy Island," was married in front of a fireplace in the house.

The property had been on the market, at \$15 million, since June 1999.

Proceeds from the Gull's Way sale will go to the Graziadio School of Business on the new Drescher campus at Pepperdine in Malibu, according to public information.
