Jack Sherrer Talks about his leadership role in Psi Upsilon fraternity at Pepperdine and How it connected with Bill Wishard and Rotary



Editor's Note: When Pepperdine decided in 1998 to only have fraternities on campus that were affiliated with national fraternities and existing campus fraternity that had been associated with community and international service and whose president was Sam Schmidt found the ideal national fraternity in Psi Upsilon. Psi Upsilon Alumni of eastern colleges were asked to help launch the new fraternity at Pepperdine and Bill Wishard and Jack Corrodi, who were Psi Upsilon alumni at Williams College and Wesleyan College, respectively, became advisors and mentors to new Pepperdine fraternity. Bill has remained in that capacity. Jack was introduced to the Malibu Rotary Club by Malibu Rotary Club Past President Bill Wishard. Bill asked Jack to talk about his experience with Psi Upsilon at the last Malibu Rotary Club meeting we asked Jack to write highlights of what he had to say:

I am so thankful to have been a member of Psi Upsilon for the past 5 years. As a freshman, I found many men who I looked up to immensely, and as a chapter leader, I wished to be that role model for a new generation of brothers. Psi U has been an integral part of my college experience, and the organization continues to be a highly desirable and influential group on campus as our organization is wide-reaching in its scope and impact on many parts of campus life. I have witnessed a remarkable transformation of this organization from my perceived 'high' of the group as a Freshman, to a seeming low point my junior year- many of the standards of the group had been replaced by apathetic members and questionable behavior. Over the past semesters and moving into the new year, this fraternity has begun to experience a rebirth in which we are not only resurrecting the 'golden days of old', but we are laying the foundation for a new and even more powerful organization rooted in the uniquely strong moral character of our members and fraternity, commitment to excellence in our personal academics and service participation, and our renewed focus to engage and connect with our alumni. Today, we have not only achieved previously met benchmarks, but have excelled in new key metrics as well. Over a period of three semesters, we transformed from having the lowest GPA of all Greek organizations to the highest. In the Fall of 2014, our chapter set a new fundraising record by completely reimagining our annual fundraiser, Psi U Think You Can Dance, to grow our attendance to the largest on record for a Greek event at the school- 753 attendees. In one night, our organization brought in over 22 thousand dollars from attendance receipts, retail items, and auction items to benefit the Sam Schmidt Paralysis Foundation. In that same year, our members completed over 1/3 of all logged service hours of all undergraduates at Pepperdine University, setting a record for both the school and for Psi Upsilon!

It is my belief that this level of accountability and organizational structure which we have implemented will allow our chapter to flourish in the coming years, and fortunately we have already begun to experience how even the most basic reforms such as that with dues collections and enforcement of academic minimums have strengthened the fraternity. The amazing potential of our members could not have been fully utilized without a proper vision and structure, although it ultimately took a multilateral approach to reach our goals together.

It was in the weakest of moments when we were able to make the biggest and most meaningful reforms to our organization.

I have learned invaluable social and business organizational skills through being the Treasurer, President, and later North American Ambassador of the Psi Upsilon Foundation. Although I may have grand aspirations for the future direction of our men, I have learned our operations must be a group effort; by delegating and entrusting certain projects with members, we have become not only more efficient, but more effectively unified in our transformation. Additionally through entrusting members of our younger pledge classes with projects and operational tasks, we are helping to preserve our traditions, strategies, and successes with our future generations. As a testament to the sustainability of our policies, the chapter was recently given multiple awards for the 2015 year including Chapter of the Year, Advisor of the Year (Justin Schneider), and Service Organization of the Year.
