

He said there was a great spirit of bringing people together, with hugs and a wonderful contrast with day's news from Baton Rouge, and events the previous week in Dallas.

David Zielski can set up a Conference call at our normal meeting time at noon on August 3. Even people who are out of town but have access to the internet can paticipate in the discussion.


