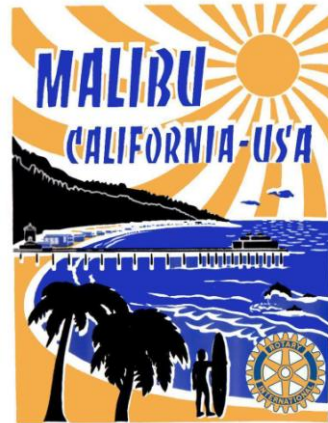

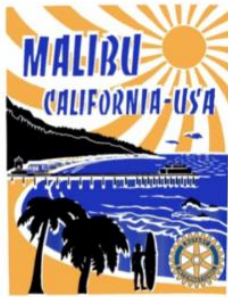
Malibu Rotary Club Holds Successful Mixer at Casa Escobar on March 19
