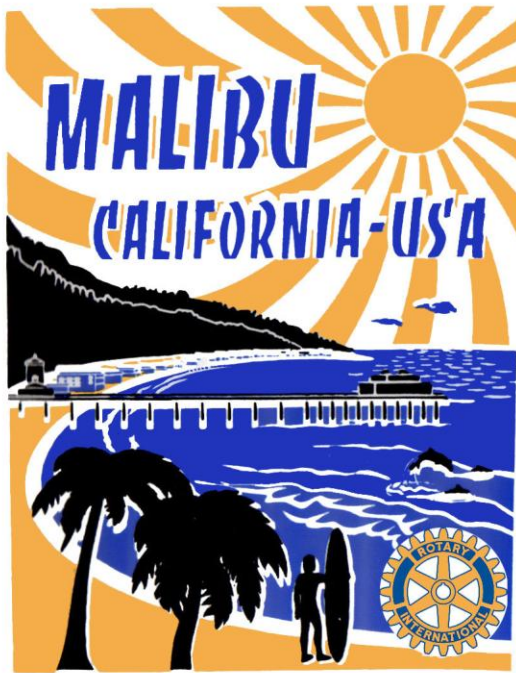

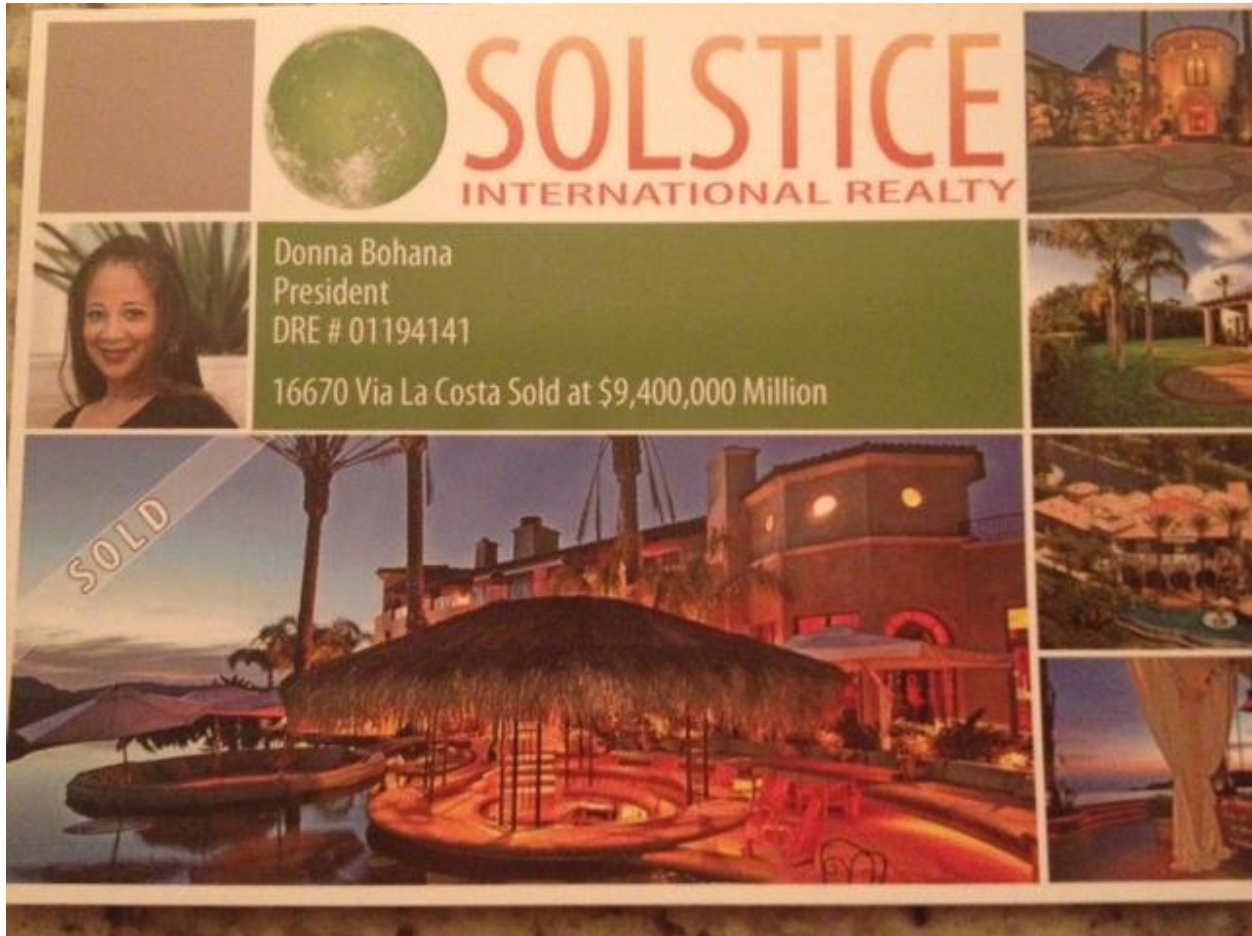
There are a couple of days when she does not have the property leased and is will let the Malibu Rotary Club use the house for an event on May
