Malibu Rotary Club Presentation of \$3300 Scholarship To Anthony Pedro Marron For El Camino Fire Fighting Academy



Anthony Marron was presented a \$3300 Scholarship Award to attend El Camino Firefighting Academy by the Malibu Rotary Club at a special meeting of the club May 17 2017. On May 17 Malibu Rotary Club will awarded a \$3300 Scholarship to Anthony Pedro Marron, an EMT currently with CARE who takes 911 calls out of the City of Commerce. He has been accepted and enrolled at El Camino Fire Academy at El Camino College in Torrance. The Malibu Rotary unanimously voted to award Anthony the scholarship at the Malibu Rotary Club meeting April 19, 2017 after viewing a video which was part of the scholarship application process.

In order to apply, students had to email Malibu Rotary Club a 60-90 second video explaining :

(1) Why they want to be a firefighter, and

(2) How winning the \$3,300 scholarship would positively impact their life.

Anthony's video was submitted on time and all who viewed it agreed he was a worthy candidate but the unanimous winner of the scholarship prize. The May 17 meeting of the Malibu Rotary Club, which was the meeting at which the award was to be presented, was therefore a special one, held in the main room of Pepperdine Graziadio Executive Center, and at which a light continental breakfast was served.

Anthony, his parents Hugo and Trisha, his girl friend Susana attended, as did Dean of Industry and Technology Division of El Camino Community College Dr Stephanie Rodriguez (who had received her Ph.D from Pepperdine) and Chief of the El Camino College Fire Fighting Academy Captain Bill Melendez.

Malibu Rotary Club;s newest member Michelle Sanamaria, led in the search for Fire Fighting Candidate the day she became a member of the club, going to fire stations and talking to the administration of fire fighting academies after Margo Neal was able to apply for and get the vocational school scholarship grant from Rotary District 5280. In making the presentation on behalf ot the Malibu Rotary Club Michelle thanked Margo Neal for her preliminary work getting the grant for the scholarship. Margo was unable to attend the presentation ceremony.

The criteria was very specific about how could qualify for the award. One of the main Fire Fighting academies in Los Angeles County is the one at El Camino College. Michelle had talked to its chief, Bill Melendez, and told applicant Anthony Marron about it. Anthony told us it was his girl friend Susana who encouraged him to try for the scholarship and she was the one who recorded the required application video for him.

Anthony told us he has wanted to be a Fire Fighter for a while. He works with fire fighters as an EMT, and has been impressed by how they save lives, and the calmness they have in

emergency situations. He wants to and believes he can do that too. He believes it would be very fulfilling to provide this kind of service to his community.

Fire Captain Bill Melendez says El Camino has 2 full time academies each year. They have 5 rigs and about 30 students, and there is usually about 1 woman in each class. Candidates have to pass a battery of physical and academic tests. Graduates of the academy usually have jobs waiting for them when they graduate, either in California or in another state..
