Malibu High School Senior Sarah Brand, Recipient of Malibu Rotary Club Scholarship, Tells Rotarians About Her Plans



Malibu High School Senior Sarah Brand was the speaker at the Malibu Rotary Club meeting on May 24. She was the recipient of a Malibu Rotary Club Scholarship and will be a freshman at University of California at Berkeley this fall.

It is the second week in a row the Malibu Rotary Club featured a recipient of a Malibu Rotary Club scholarship as a speaker. Last week a vocational scholarship was given by the club to Anthony Marron who will be using it to help pay his tuition at the Fire Fighting Academy at El Camino College.

Sarah Brand was born in Madison, Wisconsin when her mother was a student at the University of Wisconsin. Sarah's mother is now a Professor of Sociology at UCLA and Sarah said that she spent most of her earlier years going to various schools across the country as her mother went to graduate schools and took positions at various colleges. Moving around has given Sarah a sense of family. She didn't know what school she would be going to or her new friends at a new school but her family would always be there for her. She has lived in Malibu since she was in 6th grade.

At Malibu High School Sarah was Captain of Cheerleaders, ASB treasurer, and has been an outstanding student. Being Cheer Captain has helped her being a leader and being ASB treasurer has helped her in drafting a budget.

At Cal Berkley Sarah hopes to major in Sociology of Religion. She has always had an interest in sociology because of her mother, and has recently developed an interest in religion because of her boy friend, Keaton Brewster, who was one of the students the Malibu Rotary Club sent to RYLA camp in 2015 (see Malibu Rotary Club Surfwriter May 20 2015).. Keaton's father Jay is Professor of Biology at Pepperdine University and Keaton will be attending Abilene Christian University in Texas, which is an affiliate of Pepperdine University.


