

Malibu Rotary Club Joins Malibu Chamber at Legacy Park in Malibu to Celebrate Veterans Day--

Speakers are women in the US Military who talk about the increasing role of women in this country's armed services



Although the Malibu Rotary was invited participate in the 16th Annual Veterans Day Public Ceremony by Malibu Rotary Club's newest member Malibu Chamber CEO Mark Persson, Malibu Rotary is not listed as a host or sponsor on the cover but is listed along with all the other service clubs, dozens of businesses, and everyone else inside the program. Most Malibu Rotarians did come to the event, brought cases of water, and Malibu Rotary had a table near the entrance to the event.

A large crowd enjoyed the Veterans Day program. The Malibu High School Band, Our Lady of Malibu Choir, and others performed. A highlight was the performance of award winning singer and songwriter Kathy Bee singing "I am an American."



Malibu Mayor Laura Rosenthal introduced Master of Ceremonies US Navy Commander Valerie Overstreet who is stationed at Pt Magu.

Commander Overstreet proved to be the perfect MC, moving the long program along swiftly, complimenting all the participants including the six other female military people whom she introduced.

The daughter of Capt. Gilman E. Rud, a decorated Navy pilot and former commander of the Blue Angels, Overstreet became the first female commander of an E-2C Hawkeye squadron — VAW-117 or the "Wallbangers" in 2009.

Valerie Overstreet knew as a little girl that she was meant to wear a uniform, catapult herself off the deck of an aircraft carrier and fly. "No one ever told me it wasn't possible."

Overstreet said she was lucky that she was among the first female pilots finishing flight school after laws were changed to allow women to fill combat roles in the mid-1990s.

"I've loved it the whole way," she said of her career.

Her job is to lead the 173-member squadron, which includes pilots, flight and ground crews. The E-2C Hawkeyes act as sort of mini-Airborne Warning and Control Systems, working as the eyes and ears of the ships and planes that make up a carrier strike group. They help to keep flight crews in communication with ground forces so that operations work together seamlessly.

The odd looking twin-engine planes have a large dish mounted on top and a lot of sophisticated equipment inside providing early warning and command and control for the fleet.

A graduate of Virginia Tech, Overstreet became a naval aviator in June 1994. She has served on several deployments in support of combat operations in Iraq and Afghanistan. Her service also includes combat missions during Operation Desert Fox and Operation Southern Watch, enforcing the no-fly zone over Iraq in the late 1990s, operations over Kosovo and two counternarcotic deployments in the Caribbean.

The theme of all the women who followed Commander Overstreet to the podium was similar. They were thankful for the women who preceded them, paving the way for their own military careers.

Commander Overstreet introduced Carlotta Tarver, Senior Master Sergent, U.S. Air Force; Marjorie Dukatz, U.S. Marine Corps; Andrea Essig, U.S. Air Force; April Brand, U.S. Navy; Nonique McLauren, U.S. Navy; Shane McGarret, U.S. Air Force; and the oldest of the group, 90 year old Ethel Margolin, who retired as a member of Women's Army Corps (WAC), which was the women's branch of the United States Army. It was created as an auxiliary unit, the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps (WAAC) on 15 May 1942 by Public Law 554 and converted to full status as the WAC on 1 July 1943. She joined just as World War II ended but decided to stay.

The Malibu Veterans Day event was a big success and we thank Mark Persson, all the volunteers from the Chamber, and Commander Overstreet for doing such an efficient job in staging it.
