A View from the Sheriff's Office - We'll hear from **Jim McDonnell**, LA County Sheriff, on Law Enforcement Challenges and Leadership.



Puerto Rico - Our club is asking that each of us contribute \$100 to the Puerto Rico water project, which we can do by way of a check made out to the Manhattan Beach Rotary Foundation, earmarked for Puerto Rico. We heard from Jimmy Gonzalez, former District Governor in Puerto Rico and now an active Rotarian locally. He described the difficulty of rebuilding his fair island after two hurricanes, widespread destruction, and emigration of Puerto Ricans (who are American citizens) to the mainland.



BCHD - Beach Cities Health District CEO Tom Bakaly, formerly Hermosa Beach City Manager, briefed us on the preventive health services this District provides to the three Beach Cities. This public agency, located on the former pig farm that became South Bay Hospital and is now BCHD, is responsible for wide-ranging facilities from AdventurePlex to Sunrise Assisted Living to its own workout facility to Blue Zone restaurants, worksites, schools and grocery stores. So-called “Moais” have formed—small groups to address health issues. A major future development is the Healthy Living Campus, upgrading the old hospital to create 400 units of assisted living.



Water - Water, water everywhere—Niger, the Aquarium, Puerto Rico, on a pig farm—it seems that, when the health and welfare of the needy among us and around us are being addressed, Manhattan Beach Rotarians are in the mix. It’s a good mix to be in.
