two other Rotary Clubs, Miami Rotary and Houston Rotary, in putting this trip together.

Brad then elaborated on a gadget that his group has promoted called the "bio-Sand filter". We saw video clips of how another Rotarian, Bob Hilder, had also promoted this gadget and used his own personal foundation to make repeated trips to Dominican Republic to install and educate people how to use it. Apparently, this gadget attaches to a local water source and filters out most impurities and bacteria. One filter usually produces four liters of water at the stationary source. It is also being used to clean stream water as it passes through the filter. A few members had questions about all this.

Brad said that one Rotary clubs

built bakeries in El Salvador and the bakeries are providing training and jobs for local citizens.

There have also been wheelchair projects that District 5820 has sponsored.
