Rabbi has a list of impressive credentials. After serving in New Jersey and Florida, he is now the spiritual leader of Congregation Ner Tamid of South Bay in Palos Verdes. The subject of his presentation was "Church and State."

The discussion was deep and thought-provoking. Jeret discussed both what the Founding Fathers, writers of the Declaration of Independence and of the Constitution, had in mind relative to the separation of Church and State. The Founding Fathers wanted to protect the freedom of all religions, no matter the size or belief of the body. Jeret extrapolated this position to today's issues. For example, abortion and gay marriage are continually addressed by both Church and

State, yet resolution eludes us. Also Jeret indicated it would be ideal if all religions, whether large or small in size, could exchange ideas and learn from one another without trying to convert members. Also interesting is that the our Thanksgiving holiday is observed by citizens of all faiths. No other holiday has such universal appeal. Wouldn't it be nice if there were more common points of reference?

Energy for this writer's brain was not sufficient to keep up with such a thought-provoking discussion. However, I believe the above summaries the body of the speaker's talk.
