

MUSIC CONTEST

Composition:

1. Contestants may be vocalists or instrumentalists.

2. A piano will be available for performance or accompaniment.

Contestants are responsible for providing their own accompanist.

All other instrumentalists must bring their own instruments.

An instrumental recording may be used for accompaniment. A CD player will be available.

If the instrumental recording is loaded on a computer, contestants must provide the necessary cords/cables to plug into the LMU PA system.

3. <u>The performance time is 4:00-6:00</u> <u>minutes</u>. There will be a timer to indicate when a performance is nearing the 6 min. mark, and again when to stop. If a performance goes beyond 6 minutes, points will be deducted from the contestant's score.

District Contest Cash Prizes:

1 st Place	\$1,000.00*	
2 nd Place	\$	500.00
3 rd Place	\$	250.00

The First Place Winner may be invited to perform at the Rotary 5280 District Conference at Lake Arrowhead on May 5 - 7, 2017.

Official Rules:

1. Only one music contestant per Rotary Club is allowed.

2. Contestant must be currently enrolled in high school or home schooled and of high school age.

3. Contestant will compete at the sponsoring Rotary Club by February 11, 2017. Clubs may determine awards for winners at club level competition.

4. Club winners will advance to the District finals to be held March 11,
2017 at Loyola Marymount University by <u>application coordinated by</u> <u>sponsoring Rotary Club</u>.

5. Registration/Application must be <u>received</u> by the Rotary District Office, no later than **February 11, 2017**.

6. Entry fees must be <u>received</u> by the District Office no later thanFebruary 11, 2017.

7. If there is only one contestant for the District Music Contest, he or she must perform the piece on March 11, 2017.

8. Parent or legal guardian permission required. See Registration/Application.

General Instructions:

1. Download the Contest Forms: Flyer, Rules, Registration and Juror Evaluation Form from District Website – <u>www.Rotary5280.org</u>

2. Begin contacting contestants at local schools and community clubs in September.

3. The Contestant Registration form must be filled out online on the District 5280 Website <u>www.Rotary5280.org</u> no later than **February 11, 2017**.

If the contestant is under 18 years of age, a copy of the Contestant Registration form must be printed out and given to the Contestant to have their parent/guardian sign. This form must then be mailed to the District Office no later than **February 25**, **2017.**

4. The Entry fee must be <u>received</u> at District Office by February 11, 2017:

**Clubs 24 members or less	s - \$80.00
**Clubs 25-49 members -	\$135.00
**Clubs 50+ members -	\$190.00
