QUALIFICATIONS

- ❖ Must be a high school senior.
- ❖ Maintained at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA (to be verified).
- ❖ Must be college bound (vocational school, junior college or university).
- ❖ Must live in a single-parent or guardianship household.

- ❖ **Must have participated in some philanthropic activity for community, school, or the world.**

If you meet all of the above qualifications, please complete the attached application and submit an essay (less than 500 words) about the activities which support the criteria stated above.
