Jerry Jen is the current President of the Playa Venice Sunrise Rotary Club. Jerry was born and raised in Los Angeles, after his parents proudly immigrated to the United States and became citizens. Jerry's parents never had an opportunity for a formal education beyond middle school, as both of his parents had to start working very early in their lives to help support their respective families.

Even while Jerry was growing up, Jerry's parents worked 11-12 hours a day, 6-7 days a week, to support Jerry and his sister, always emphasizing the importance of education, and how attending college would provide Jerry and his sister with opportunities that his parents never had.

With his parents' endless support and emphasis on education, Jerry was a first generation college student, who attended and graduated from the University of California Berkeley, and later, obtained his Juris Doctor degree from Western State University. Jerry would not have been able to do so, if it was not for his parents.

The recipient of this scholarship must be the first to attend college in their family, and is planning to attend a California based <u>public</u> school (Ex: University of California, Cal State, Community College, etc.). Applicants must submit a short essay explaining how their parent or guardian(s) have supported them in their youth, and how such efforts have influenced and helped them thrive in school.

If you are a graduating senior who is college bound and meet the following qualifications, you may apply for the Jerry Jen Presidential Scholarship.

QUALIFICATIONS

✤ Must be a high school senior.

- ✤ Maintained at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA (to be verified).
- Must be college bound (vocational school, junior college or university).
 Must be the first in the family to attend college
- Must be attending a California <u>public</u> college, university, or vocational school.

If you meet all of the above qualifications, please complete the attached application and submit an essay (less than 500 words) about the activities which support the criteria stated above.
