- Live, work or volunteer in Grapevine
- A long history of serving the community in leadership roles
- Contributions have made a measureable positive impact

- August 10, 2017: present the chosen nominee to Rotary Board of Directors
- Mid-August: luncheon invitations to past recipients and chosen nominee
- September 13th – Present the award at the weekly luncheon in support of North Texas Giving Day.
