The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

FIRST. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

SECOND. High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

THIRD. The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

FOURTH. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

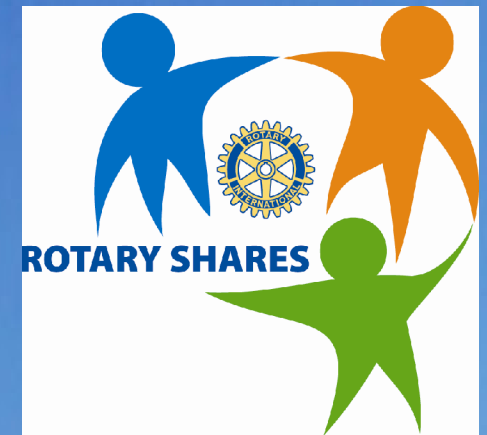
The Rotary Motto

And Many, Many, More

There are many needs both in our local community and worldwide. By working together members make significant improvements in the lives of people all over the world. We need more Rotarians to meet the growing needs of those less fortunate than us.

A willingness to serve

- Regular attendance at weekly meetings (the club average is 80%, minimum 60% is required.)
- Participation in club projects
- Participation in club fund raisers
- Active participation in one or more club committees
- Attendance at annual District Training
- Sponsorship of new members
- Club Financial Obligations
 - Initiation fee = \$185
 - Dues = \$5/week (\$20/month.)
 - Meals = \$15/week (\$60- \$75/month.)
- This means that for \$80 a month you will reap all of the benefits of Rotary membership. A BARGAIN!
- Support of The Rotary Foundation
- Rotary international sets a minimum \$100 per year per member for support of The Rotary Foundation. Many of our projects are funded through grants from the Rotary Foundation and the Glendale Sunrise Rotary Foundation (both 501c3)
