The group will drive separately down to a California town near the border, spending Friday night there. Saturday morning early, the group will caravan across the border into Tecate. The work site is located a few miles on the other side of Tecate. Dan stressed how safe the Corazon projects are. No Corazon volunteer has ever been injured or victimized by crime while in Mexico. The purpose of this work trip is to build a house in a day. There will be lots of volunteers and it is a very basic house without electricity or plumbing. The family who is to get the house helps out. Dan is looking for volunteers for this work trip. Once the house is complete, the group returns to California Saturday night for a victory dinner.
