Our speaker Thursday 12/15 was Dee Digioia. She spoke about a bullying prevention program that she has been developing at Mammoth Unified School District. She described tools for the kids to use to help defeat intimidating and hurtful behavior. She also showed a film clip of Mammoth Elementary children singing a song about stopping bullying and demonstrating assertive but non-aggressive intervention tactics. The lessons were good ones for the students and good ones for adults as well.
