Tim Bartley - Fly Fishing Faire

Today's program was presented by Tim Bartley. He is coordinating the 2012 Fly Fishing Faire put on by the Southwest Council of the Federation of Fly Fishers (FFF). The fair will take place from the 13th to the 16th of September. It will include on the water workshops from Bishop to Bridgeport. Workshops, programs and events will be headquartered at Cerro Coso and will also take place at the Edison Theater and Mammoth High School.

The FFF was founded in 1964. They were the earliest proponents of catch and release fishing. They're a nonprofit located in Livingston, Montana. The FFF has a well-respected program for certifying casting instructors. There are 15 regional councils throughout the U.S. They also have projects for wounded warriors and breast cancer survivors.

The upcoming festival is a first for FFF. In addition to on the water workshops, it will include classes in learning to fly fish, casting instruction and fly tying. There will be a film series and conservation lectures. Additionally, activities for non-fishing spouses are planned to include photography workshops and Eastern Sierra touring opportunities.
