

## International Service

Fourteen members of the Noon Rotary club and three Sunrise Rotarians were part of a group of 40 who traveled to Tecate, MX on Saturday, May 19, to build a house for the De La Rocha-Lara family. After meeting at 6 am in El Cajon, they caravanned across the border and arrived at the job site in Sierra Azul at about 8 am. They were met by the family that had donated hundreds of hours to qualify for a new house, a cement slab, and all the materials. Under the supervision of Corazon lead builders, everyone jumped in and went right to work. The walls and roof rafters were up by noon when the family provided lunch. The afternoon was spent roofing the house, installing the interior walls, loft, front door, and final painting. The house was finished in record time and the keys were turned over to the grateful family by 3:30. After farewell hugs, everyone headed back over the border and most of the group celebrated with margaritas and Mexican food at Por Favor restaurant in El Cajon.

It is safe to say that everyone who participated in this hands on service project thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity of building a house in a day and getting the rewards of presenting the keys to the family.
