Dan Watson provided an update of the Town's settlement of the airport lawsuit and the Town Council's plan to pay the \$2 million a year for 23 years. The Council's plan includes a 46% reduction in the number of police officers, reducing from 17 to 10. This will result in 75% of the management team and reduce patrol staffing to no more than 2 officers on duty at any time and sometimes only one. Dan explained that the Council's plan is just a starting point and the Council wants to hear from residents and other stakeholders on how the settlement should be paid. The Council's plan did not take any funds from the voter approved measures A, R, T, and U, and it also didn't take any funds from Transportation, Tourism, or Housing. Dan recommended that everyone should become familiar with the details of the plan and then communicate their recommendations to the Council by either appearing at the next Council meeting on October 18 or sending an e-mail to Town Clerk Jamie Gray.
