## Today's Program

### Rotary Foundation - Debra Lowe

Debra Lowe brings more than ten years of fundraising experience to The Rotary Foundation. Following a 20 year career with the Walt Disney Company, Debra entered the not for profit sector as Director of Membership and Development for The Osceola Center for the Arts and from 2003-2005 she worked with The Celebration Foundation as Director of Development and Volunteer Services. Prior to coming to The Rotary Foundation, Debra served as Director of Development for Orlando Ballet where she managed all aspects of the organization's fundraising efforts in support of the Organization's main stage productions and four Orlando Ballet School campuses.

Debra has been an active Rotarian for more than ten years. She served as President of the Rotary Club of Kissimmee Bay in 2005-2006; District Grants Subcommittee Chair from 2007-2009 is now a member of the Rotary Club of Orlando where she has served as the Club TRF Chair. She is a PHF+7.

Debra joined The Rotary Foundation in 2009 as the first Major Gifts Officer on staff who lives within their assigned zone. She is a 30-year resident of Kissimmee, part of Zone 34 which encompasses the Georgia, Florida and Caribbean Rotary Districts.

In November of this year, Debra will travel to Tuscan, Arizona to participate in Miles to End Polio, a 100-mile bike ride that is part of El Tour de Tuscan. The 9,000-participant ride is one of America's largest bicycling events and offers a fantastic opportunity to raise money for polio eradication.

Rotary's team consists of 6 chosen staff members and General Secretary John Hewko. The fundraising goal is \$10 million and will include funds raised by staff members and District Designated Funds, matched 2-to-1 by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. RI President-elect John Germ has also agreed to visit the district that contributes the most for this year's event.

Debra lives with her yellow Labrador, Luna and enjoys outdoor adventures, golf and the culinary and creative arts.
