

The Camas-Washougal Ducky Derby is staged on the beautiful Washougal River between Camas and Washougal.

Now in its 21st year, the event promises the thrill of a race, the pure fun of sports entertainment and the reward of knowing the proceeds will support Rotary projects, both locally and internationally.


With the entertaining style of the event and the competitive spirit of the race, the Derby is a memorable occasion for everyone involved.

Adding to the excitement, the Derby is held the fourth weekend in July, the same weekend as the Camas Days festival, which attracts tens of thousands to downtown Camas.

Ducky Derby begins on the Third Avenue Bridge over the Washougal River when a front-loader tips its bucket and unloads 5,000 plastic ducks into the water. From there the current takes over and the ducks dash to the finish line. The fastest ducks down the river win fantastic prizes for those who have adopted them!

ROTARY PROJECTS

100% of the proceeds from the Derby directly benefit the projects supported by the Rotary Club of Camas Washougal.

PROJECTS INCLUDE:

YOUNG WOMEN & MEN IN ACTION

Rotarians and other passionate, dedicated volunteers are at the core of this 8-week program, which provides mentoring for 5th grade boys and girls at Hathaway Elementary School. The adults and students spend Wednesday afternoons together focusing on relationship skills, self-esteem building and fun.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, the club awards scholarships to at least eight high school seniors and two sophomores in an effort to encourage higher education and reward exemplary academic achievement.

WATER PROJECT IN CHENJENI, KENYA

Our club, along with several others and the Rotary International Foundation, funded and successfully completed a project to supply fresh water to Chenjeni, Kenya, helping to keep water borne diseases at bay for this community.

A GIFT OF WORDS—DICTIONARIES FOR 3RD GRADERS

To promote literacy during a key year for language development and vocabulary improvement, 3rd grade students in Camas and Washougal schools receive a personal dictionary courtesy of the Camas-Washougal Rotary.

BICYCLE HELMET PROJECT

The Camas Washougal Rotary Foundation contributed to help put bicycle helmets into the hands of Camas and Washougal police officers. The helmets are distributed by the patrolman to children and teens who could not otherwise purchase one.

POLIO ERADICATION

Rotary, along with its partners, has reduced polio cases by 99 percent worldwide since the first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.

BACKPACK PROJECT

At the start of every school year, hundreds of backpacks are stuffed with school supplies and distributed to underprivileged students in Camas and Washougal.

FIRST ROBOTICS

FIRST Robotics Team 2471, is based out of Camas High School and includes students from three local high schools. They have competed and won on a regional and national level.

SHARE HOUSE

Volunteer and financial support is provided to this outreach program for the poor and homeless in our communities.

MEALS ON WHEELS

Our dedicated army of volunteers deliver a nutritious meal, a warm smile and a safety check to help keep seniors healthy, safe and living independently in their own homes.

WALK & KNOCK

CW Rotary provides volunteer and financial support for Clark County's largest food drive. Walk & Knock has operated for more than a quarter century, and collected more than 6 million pounds of food worth nearly \$8 million dollars.


