- 1. The scholarship applicant must hold a high school diploma or G.E.D. and plan to pursue post-secondary education, either vocationally or toward a bachelor's degree. The applicant must live within the attendance area of Camas or Washougal High Schools.
- 2. The scholarship funds shall be directly applied to an accredited college, university, or vocational training program for post-high school education. The scholarship is intended for students who have not earned a bachelor's degree.
- 3. The scholarship applicant must provide the names and addresses of two references below. This application must be accompanied by a letter from each of these references. One reference must be an educator or employer. The other reference must be someone (other than a family member) who can identify your involvement in community service.
- 4. The scholarship application must be accompanied by a transcript from high school and any post-high school education that has been taken; a resume; and, two original essays. Essay requirements are as follows:
 - A. Each essay should be approximately 250 words.
 - B. Essays must be typed or computer printed, double spaced.
 - C. In the first essay, describe your career goals and how your proposed educational plan will help you attain your goals.
 - D. In the second essay, describe how you have touched people's lives in your local, state, or world community with service, and how further education will help you continue to do so.

NOTE: YOU MUST WRITE ON BOTH ESSAY TOPICS. WINNING ESSAYS MAY BE PUBLISHED IN A PUBLIC FORUM.

- 5. The completed application, resume, transcript(s), essays, and two reference letters should be sent to the Scholarship Committee, Rotary Club of Camas-Washougal, P.O. Box 716, Camas, WA 98607 <u>NO LATER</u> <u>THAN MAY 1, 2017.</u> You will not receive a receipt of your application. Applications are considered as they
- are received. All materials submitted with the application become property of the Rotary Club of Camas-Washougal and <u>WILL NOT BE RETURNED</u> to the applicant.
- 6. The Rotary Club of Camas-Washougal may award a \$1,000 scholarship. Winner will be notified by June 1, 2017.
- 7. The scholarship award will be paid by the Rotary Club of Camas-Washougal directly to the registrar of the college or vocational program in which the applicant is enrolled.
- 8. The winning applicant will be invited to attend a Rotary Club meeting during June 2017 to participate in an award presentation.
- 9. By agreeing to accept a scholarship, the applicant irrevocably consents to the Rotary Club's use of applicant's image in news releases and all of its publications, including press releases, social media and websites.
