Volunteer to Help Deliver Dictionaries to Third Graders

The joint project of the Seattle 4 Education and Community Service Committees, funded by your SRSF, provides almost 600 dictionaries for third graders in some of Seattle's poorest schools. Your help is needed with the distribution to the children in their classrooms. We work in teams of two and have dictionaries for 10 schools. Time frame is late October to mid-December for the delivery. Here's what is involved:

- Set up your team's appointment with schools contact/teacher for a time to meet with the class(s)
- Pick up the dictionaries from warehouse in Tukwila
- Insert the Seattle 4 Rotary bookplate inside the front cover of each dictionary
- Present the dictionaries to each student
- Have the children write their name on the bookplate (dictionaries are theirs to keep, not a classroom resource)
- It is great fun to give the children a few look up exercises on how to use the dictionary. Third graders are a blast to work with and very grateful to receive this wonderful book.
